UPDATED SATELLITE INFORMATION – TOMORROW THROUGH SATURDAY – SOUTHEAST PA – Pennsylvania State Police Announces Media Access Areas for Services for Troopers Mack and Sisca

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania State Police (PSP) announced today the media staging areas for the services of Trooper Martin F. Mack III and Trooper Branden T. Sisca, who lost their lives in the line of duty on Monday, March 21.

The indoor portions of the funeral services for both troopers will not be open to the media, but PAcast will be livestreaming the services. The livestream link can be accessed at pacast.com/live/psp. In addition, opportunities for photos and video for the outdoor portions will be plentiful. Staff from the PSP Communications Office will also be on-hand for interviews at the staging areas.

Trooper Martin F. Mack III, Arrangements:

Public Viewing

WHEN: Wednesday, March 30 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

WHERE: Wade Funeral Home, 1002 Radcliffe St., Bristol, PA 19007.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS: Parking at the funeral home is reserved and not available to the public. Media personnel can gather and film at the corner of Lincoln and Radcliffe Streets at the Radcliffe Learning Center, which is near the funeral home. However, due to parking limitations, media vehicles are asked to park in the large parking lot at 1414 Radcliffe Street.

WHEN: Thursday, March 31 at 11 a.m.

WHERE: St. Michael the Archangel Church, 66 Levittown Parkway, Levittown, PA 19054.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS: Media personnel can park and gather across the street from the church in the Levittown Town Center parking lot (address for the plaza is 180 Levittown Center, Levittown, PA 19055). Media members are asked to park in the south area of the shopping center lot nearest to the Ross and Verizon stores. There is ample space in front of the plaza storefronts along the Levittown Parkway with a sidewalk and grassy area for photos and video.

WHEN: Friday, April 1 from 12-3 p.m. and 5-9 p.m.

WHERE: Boyd-Horrox-Givnish Funeral Home, 200 W. Germantown Pike, Norristown, PA 19401

ADDITIONAL DETAILS: Media vehicles will park in the rear corner of the parking lot behind the Friendly's restaurant, located across the street from the funeral home at 150 West Germantown Pike. Camera crews can film from the grassy area on the corner of W. Germantown Pike and Hillcrest Avenue near the funeral home.

WHERE: Perkiomen Valley High School, 509 Gravel Pike, Collegeville, PA 19426.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS: Media members are asked to park in the gravel parking lot adjacent the school's football stadium. Please don't park on the roadway, as it will be reserved for egress and parking for large fire department apparatus. The area between High School Drive and the baseball diamond has been reserved for video and photo access for media members.
