**MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN DAUPHIN COUNTY – State Officials to Outline Agency and Public Winter Preparations, Highlight New Safety Measures**

**Harrisburg, PA – Tomorrow, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Secretary Mike Carroll and Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission (PA Turnpike) Chief Operating Officer Craig Shuey** will hold a media event to discuss agency preparations and offer public tips for the upcoming winter season.

Vehicles from each agency will be on site equipped with new green lights which are incorporated with existing flashing or revolving yellow (amber) lights. This additional strategy aims to increase safety by making construction and maintenance operations more visible. PennDOT, the PA Turnpike, municipalities, and contractors working on their behalf may now install flashing or revolving green lights after Governor Josh Shapiro signed Act 78 of 2024 on July 17.
