MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN PHILLY – Shapiro-Davis Administration to Highlight \$4 Million Federal Grant to Prevent Gun Violence, Make Pennsylvania Communities Safer

Philadelphia – Lt. Gov. Austin Davis will join federal, state and local partners to highlight a \$4 million federal grant to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) at a news conference TOMORROW, Friday, Dec. 13, at 10 a.m. at Temple University Hospital, 3401 N. Broad St., Philadelphia.

The federal funding, a <u>Community Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative</u> (CVIPI) grant through the U.S. Department of Justice, will help make Pennsylvania communities safer and prevent gun violence by expanding hospital-based violence intervention programs across the Commonwealth.
