MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN ALLENTOWN – Lt. Gov. Austin Davis to Highlight State Grants for Afterschool Programs

ALLENTOWN, PA – Lt. Gov. Austin Davis will join state and local leaders to highlight more than \$11 million in state grants to provide afterschool programming and help make Pennsylvania communities safer at a news conference TOMORROW, Wednesday, Jan. 29, at 3:30 p.m. at Casa Guadalupe Center, 218 N. Second St., Allentown.

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency, which Davis leads, is providing \$11.6 million in grants to 46 organizations through the new statewide Building Opportunity through Out-of-School Time (BOOST) program. The Shapiro-Davis Administration is funding these projects to provide structured programming for at-risk school-age youth across the Commonwealth.
