MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN HARRISBURG – Governor Shapiro to Highlight Major Improvements in PA's Unemployment Compensation System, Lowest Call Wait Times in Over Six Years

Harrisburg, PA – Tomorrow, Governor Josh Shapiro and Pennsylvania Department of Labor & Industry Secretary Nancy A. Walker will join labor leaders and advocates to highlight how the Shapiro Administration's targeted investments in Pennsylvania's Unemployment Compensation (UC) have led to a faster, more efficient customer experience, including the fastest call response time in more than six years.

Since day one, **Governor Shapiro** has prioritized creating an efficient and fair unemployment system for all Pennsylvanians to ensure they receive reliable support when they lose their job through no fault of their own. In addition to reduced call wait times, the Shapiro Administration has spearheaded the hiring of nearly 400 new UC interviewers and the expansion of in-person assistance through UC Connect.
