MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN ALLENTOWN – Lt. Gov. Austin Davis to Highlight Investments to Revitalize Communities

ALLENTOWN, PA – Lt. Gov. Austin Davis will join state and local leaders to highlight \$70 million in state tax credits approved through the Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) at a news conference **TOMORROW, Friday, Jan. 23, at 11 a.m. at Resurrected Life Community Church, 620 Hamilton St., Allentown.**

The program, which provides tax credits to businesses that contribute to nonprofit organizations' efforts to revitalize communities, [will support 405 projects across the state](#). There are [37 approved projects in the Lehigh Valley](#) (totaling more than \$5.5 million in tax credits for projects in Berks, Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton and Schuylkill counties) – including a project by Community Action Lehigh Valley to help Center City youth in Allentown.
