**MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY –
Shapiro Administration to Make Major Economic Development
Announcement in Shippensburg**

Shippensburg, PA – Tomorrow, **Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Secretary Rick Siger** and **Department of Agriculture Secretary Russell Redding** will announce the Commonwealth's investment in Schreiber Foods to create jobs and grow Pennsylvania's manufacturing and agriculture sectors.

From day one, **Governor Josh Shapiro and his Administration** have worked to spur economic development in Pennsylvania — securing over **\$40.4 billion** in private sector investments and creating **more than 22,400 jobs**.

Pennsylvania has the only growing economy in the Northeast and **Governor Shapiro's [2026-27 proposed budget](#)** builds on three years of historic progress to maintain the Commonwealth's status as an economic leader.
