MEDIA ADVISORY: TOMORROW IN ALLEGHENY COUNTY – Governor Shapiro, Lt. Governor Davis to Encourage Working Pennsylvanians to Take Advantage of New State Tax Credit to Get More Money Back on Their Taxes

Turtle Creek, PA – Tomorrow, **Governor Josh Shapiro** and **Lieutenant Governor Austin Davis** will visit a tax clinic in Allegheny County with legislative and community leaders to encourage eligible Pennsylvanians to take advantage of the new [Working Pennsylvanians Tax Credit \(WPTC\)](#) as they file their taxes prior to this year's April 15th tax deadline so they can receive more money back as part of their tax refunds.

One of seven tax cuts **Governor Shapiro** and **Lieutenant Governor Davis** have secured since taking office, the WPTC was created in the [2025-26 budget](#) and is expected to provide **\$193 million in tax relief** for **approximately 940,000 working Pennsylvanians** this tax season.
